



DEPARTMENTAL MEETINGS

Department of English is one of the biggest departments of the university with a large number of faculty members. There are 8 permanent faculty members and 12 visiting faculty members working strenuously for the development of the department. Departmental meetings are very important as they reflect an environment of teamwork, a struggle to achieve the same goals, overcome the obstacles and strategize the new measures taken by the department.

8TH MEETING

First meeting of the department of Fall 2021 was held online to **welcome** the new visiting faculty. Head of the Department advised that the aim of this semester should be to provide comprehensive and flawless **education** and instruction to our students. Medium and mode of education should not be a hurdle in our aim. Online education is the norm now and we are all equipped with a certain experience of it now. The HOD encouraged the teachers to make students realize the importance of **vaccination** against COVID-19. The Department of English is soon going to launch a **Writing Centre** and soon a formal presentation will be given to all stakeholders. The Writing Centre is open to all faculty members, who can contribute in it with whatever capacities they can. Furthermore, the HOD distributed the **departmental activities** and the general instructions for the semester.



9TH & 10TH MEETING

Second meeting of the Department of English, fall semester 2021 was held on 13th November, 2021 via zoom. Head of the department began meeting by congratulating faculty members on the successful **inauguration of the Academic Writing Centre.** AWC made quite an impact by engaging faculty from all the departments. He further added that a few new projects like a book reading circle, department's research journal are under pipeline and soon they will be materialized. MPhil program of the department will begin soon too as university administration intends to hire more faculty which is great news for the department. **Departmental QEC and Student's affair cell** will be made.

Another meeting of the Department of English, fall semester 2021 was held on 18th November, 2021. Head of the Department asked faculty to be vigilant regarding their classes and observe official working hours. HOD further added that faculty members should spare some time other than teaching hours, for the assistance of students. Department of English is soon going to launch its very own research journal. Tentative name of the journal is **Jhang Journal of Language and Literary Studies (JLLS)**. Dr. Ayesha Ashraf has been assigned the duty to work up on the CFP, panel of editors and reviewers etc. AWC will soon be organizing a seminar which will be open for all university students, faculty and staff to attend. Moreover, a film club focusing on the visual and performing arts and an annual grand play based on literary classics will also be performed. An alumni gathering will be done in December and for this purpose Ms. Shafqat has been asked to collect date from 2005 onwards.

11TH & 12TH MEETING

Another meeting of the Department of English, fall semester 2021 was held on 25th November, 2021. It was about the orientation ceremony that the department is arranging for the new students of the department to help them understand their degree program, semester system and get familiar with faculty and staff of university. Language Aptitude Test (LAT) will be taken from the students of first semester. This test will guide the mechanism of admissions and teaching process for the coming years. The department of English launched a book club titled 'Bookism' for the revival and promotion of book reading. This book club will bring avid book readers across university in a physical space where they will be able to converse on books, discuss and share their opinions and experiences. University of Jhang is going to organize a literary festival in the month of December and it would be a huge opportunity for the Department of English to socialize and interact with the literary giants of the country. Mission, Vision and goals of the department for the academic year 2021-2022 will be shared in the function along with celebrating the achievements of the students. Twelfth meeting of the Department of English, fall semester 2021 was held on 2nd December, 2021. Head of the department informed faculty members that a new session (2021-2025) of BS English will be starting from 6th December, 2021. HOD briefed the whole faculty about the planning of the orientation. Department will create a WhatsApp group for freshmen to greet them and guide them about commencement of classes, time table, room number, Academic Calendar and buses routes. Final **Exams of BS** Sem V and VII are going to held from 5th January 2022.

QUALITY ENHANCEMENT CELL ENGLISH

Department of English, University of Jhang held an important meeting of QEC on 1st Dec, 2021. The meeting was held by Ms Saima Yasin with other faculty members including Ms. Shafqat Naseem, Ms. Nimra Zafar, Ms. Asima Irshad, Ms. Iqra Yousif, Sir Ghulam Yasin and Mr. Aslam. All the faculty members shared their assigned work related to the making of new course outlines for English. The objective of the meeting was to discuss the uniform course policy for the Department of English, UOJ. Modifications were being made by Ms. Saima and Ms. Shafqat.

Department of English Literature, UOJ held its second QEC meeting on 15th December, 2021 under the supervision of Head of Department, Dr. Abdullah. The important points of meeting are given below:

The objective of the meeting was to discuss and finalize the uniform course outline policy in soft form presented by the members in previous meeting of QEC. The scheme of studies for all the allied departments of English in UOJ was compiled in soft form and it was overviewed by assessing the subjects being taught there. The objective was to enhance the quality of material studied there. Department of English, UOJ will only follow the curriculum based on HEC including the major subject's titles:

- Reading and Writing Skills
- Composition Writing
- Communication and Presentational Skills
- Academic Reading and Writing Skills.




FOCUS GROUP DISCUSSIONS

The Department of English at University of Jhang has always kept quality and excellence of teaching as its core objective. Time and again focus group discussions have been arranged by the department to share best teaching practices, identify the weaknesses of one thing or another. In the current semester (fall'21) two focus group discussions were held by the department. First focus group held on 23 October, 2021 which was aimed to improve the **content of foundational English courses**, to make them relevant and uniform across university. As the department of English has to offer foundational courses to all the departments of university, it becomes really important to prepare outlines which are subject specific, address the core needs of major degree programs while keeping the ability to communicate in English language at center. Second focus group was held on 8 December, 2021 to discuss issues related to paper checking. All faculty members were invited to become a part of the discussion by bringing the checked scripts of their students. All faculty members **examined the scripts and discussed** the common mistakes made by students and techniques by which such mistakes can be avoided. FGD went successful as faculty members shared their experiences with each other regarding the issues related to examination process and paper checking.

ACADEMIC WRITING CENTRE (AWC) INAUGURATION

Taking into consideration the ground realities of academic standards/writing abilities of enrolled students, under the supervision and outstanding efforts of Dr. Muhammad Abdullah inaugural ceremony of AWC was held at University of Jhang on 10 November 2021. Respected vice chancellor Dr. Shahid Munir inaugurated the academic writing center along with honorable chief guest Dr. Waseem Anwar who is director ICPWE, Kinnaird College Lahore. The academic writing center aims to facilitate students, faculty, and staff of UOJ and the community of Jhang to improve their art of writing. Our motive is "one stop solution for your writing needs". Dr. Muhammad Abdullah along with his team including Mr. Ghulam Yaseen, Ms Tayyiba Maryam, Ms Saima Yasin, Ms Nimra Zafar, Ms Asima Arshad, and Ms Noor-ul-ain worked hard to make the dream reality. 


BOOKISM INAUGURATION

- To encourage conversations vital for the community


















JHANG KAY SITARAY





ORIENTATION OF NEW STUDENTS



• Socratic Seminar

Socratic seminar is a discussion based on a text where open ended questions are asked based on the content of the chosen text. She arranged a series of Socratic seminars in her class while teaching Greek Literature to encourage students to think critically, respond to the narrative in their own way and articulate their thoughts. She has found Socratic seminars to be more helpful in teaching than lecture methods as students were actively engaged. While she was teaching Elizabethan and Restoration Drama this fall, she also encouraged students to come up with open ended questions and situations relevant to the text under discussion for her Socratic seminars. It really helped students with probing into key ideas and helped me finish my tasks on time.
