WELCOMING NEW VISITING FACULTY


MS.ASIFA IQBAL

PDNET-2022



The Professional Development for Novice English Teachers (PDNET) program-2022 is a fully funded teacher training series offering five days of intensive residential training for novice and prospective English Language Teachers (ELTs) current students or recent graduates of teaching professional degree programs (B. Ed, M. Ed, TEFL and ELT) from across Pakistan. Out of thousand plus applicants, 400 candidates were being short-listed for interview and 180 were the lucky ones.

Four Visiting Lecturers of University of Jhang belonging to Department of English literature were selected for this training. Ms Nimra Zafar and Ms Sumaira Majeed were selected for this training as Novice English teachers. Sir Ghulam Yaseen and Miss Asima Arshad attended the workshop as prospective trainees. OVICE ENGLISH TEAC RAM 2022




